

Parents are required to fill out an application for each child being enrolled in the Gold Medal After-School & Summer Camp Program. At the time of enrollment, parents will sign a Discipline and Behavior Management Policy. Gold Medal Summer Camp Program will seek to establish and maintain a good relationship and to facilitate communication and cooperation.

SUMMER CAMP




Summer Camp opens at 7:30am and closes at 6:00pm. Upon arrival, make sure your child has already been served breakfast and has a non-microwavable lunch that is packed with an ice pack if needed. We do not have a microwave or refrigerator available. Make sure your child has the necessary attire for gym play and field trips planned for that day and any extra spending money necessary for field trips, if wanted.

Thomas Gymnastics has secure Sign-In/Sign-Out Protocols that will be implemented to ensure the safety of each child. Parent's/Guardians should download the app called ProCare. More information will be found within our welcome letter which is provided closer to the start of Summer Camp. We offer drive thru pickup from 4:00 – 6:00. A staff member will be present at this time to make sure your child is safely escorted to their vehicle.





Parents are required to fill out the attached registration form for each child being enrolled in the Summer Camp program. At the time of enrollment, make sure all documents including waivers are signed before processing.



Gold Medal Summer Camp will seek to establish and maintain a good relationship and to facilitate communication and cooperation. Parents are welcome to visit the program at any time, especially on birthdays and special occasions. Information on any special field trips will be posted.

Fees and Payment Process

The program fee for our Carolina Forest location is \$165.00 per week (Conway: \$155) for registrations made before May 14th, and \$175.00 (Conway: \$165) for registrations on or after that date. This fee covers a t-shirt and one full week of enrollment and most field trips. To secure your spot for each week of attendance, a non-refundable deposit of \$10.00 is required.

For those opting for the daily rate, it is \$55.00 before May 14th and \$65.00 on or after that date, which does not include a t-shirt.

However, you can purchase a t-shirt separately for \$15.

Payments must be made each week on Monday of the week in which your child is attending. If payment is not made by the end of the day Monday, there will be a \$20 late fee added to your account and your child will not be able to return to camp until payment is made.



METHODS OF PAYMENT

All methods of payment are accepted; cash, check, credit card/debit and automated draft. We will bill all accounts every Friday for the following weeks tuition. If you are set up for auto draft, your card will be charged at that time as well.

CANCELLATION

Camp Cancellation notice MUST be given two weeks before the start of that particular camp week in order to not be charged for the remainder balance of that week. If no notice or less than a 2 week notice is given, payment for the remaining balance will be required, no exceptions moving forward.

LATE PICK UP

If my child is picked up **after 6:00 pm** there will be a \$20.00 late pick up fee. At 6:15pm there will be an increase of \$1.00 per minute thereafter.

ENROLLMENT





ARRIVAL and **DEPARTURE**

Arrival: Parents are to drop off and pick up their children at the gym. We WILL NOT allow drop off or pick up at the field trip location. Thomas Gymnastics uses a system called ProCare. All parents/primary guardians should download the app so you receive daily updates. This is how you will sign your child in and out of the program, as well. All authorized pickup personal will have their OWN 4-digit code but will NOT have to download the app.

Departure: We have a drive-thru pick-up available from 4:00–6:00 p.m. A child will only be released to the parent or the person assigned to get them, which will be noted on the child's enrollment application and in ProCare. The parents must notify the front desk if there is a change in who will be picking up a child. Parents and other adults picking up children must sign them out and be prepared to show identification if requested. You may call ahead to let us know you are on the way to pick up your child and we will have your child ready to go by the time you arrive. You could message into the Pro-Care app with your name, as well as the child's name in which you are picking up, so we can have the child ready for your arrival.

SUPERVISION and DISCIPLINE

Our goal is to make the Gold Medal Summer Camp Program a fun and safe learning environment for everyone. We strive to teach our children self-discipline and self-respect. If circumstances do occur privileges will be limited or taken away until the child can participate appropriately, and a written explanation will be sent home.

PERSONAL BELONGINGS

Thomas Gymnastics' staff members will not be held responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items. Please leave all valuables at home, including electronics. We will keep found items till the end of each week. If your belongings are left after we close on Friday, the items will be donated.

Procedures

▼ Field Trip Cost

Field trips are included in the weekly cost. There are a couple of exceptions on higher cost outings. You will be notified about these as soon as our booking is in place. Our weekly field trip schedules will determine the destination, costs, and further details regarding each specific trip.



✓ HEALTH POLICIES



Children attending the program should have school insurance or private coverage. If a child becomes ill during the day, they will be isolated from the group and parents will be notified immediately and must pick up the child as soon as possible. If the child needs emergency care and the parents cannot be located; they will be taken to the doctor who is authorized by the parents on the enrollment application. In case of a serious accident requiring emergency treatment, the emergency room of McLeod or Conway will be used. The staff will not administer medicine without special/written permission and specific instructions from the child's doctor. **Prescription medicine must be sent in the original container with instructions on the label.**

✓ INCLEMENT WEATHER

The summer camp program has the potential of closing during inclement weather. Thomas Gymnastics will notify via ProCare, email and social media posts with any closing as soon as the decisions have been made. Thomas Gymnastics will give as ample notice as possible.

✓ Myrtle Waves



If your child will be in grade 3 or higher and you would like them to go to Myrtle Waves with their group (group 3-5) you will need to purchase a season pass. You MUST purchase this pass through Myrtle Waves directly. There will be NO outside food permitted in the park this year. Only exception will be you may send your child with a water bottle. Lunch options for Myrtle Waves this year will be Pizza ONLY, Cheese or Pepperoni! These lunch purchases will be made through your parent portal ONLY, in the amount of \$10.00 or less (subject to change based on Myrtle Waves decision) weekly! If you choose to not purchase lunch meals through your portal, you MUST provide your child with no less than \$10.00 in order to allow

- Lunch items must be pre-purchased through our online portal.
 The weekly menu will be available for selection ahead of time,
 and we encourage you to place your order before the start of the
 week to guarantee your meal.
- Options will include hot meals, lunchables, PB&J's. and more.

Vending Items (Available for Purchase During Lunch and Afternoon Snack):

- In addition to the pre-purchased lunch items, we have a selection of vending machine items available for purchase throughout the day.
- Vending items can be purchased during lunch or during the afternoon snack break, giving the kids the flexibility to grab a quick snack as needed.
- If you'd like to purchase vending items, please send cash with your student.

Discipline and Rehavior Management

RULES

- Students must keep hands, feet, and objects to himself/herself.
- Students must show respect to ALL staff and other students.
- Students must use appropriate language.
- Students must use movement and voice levels that are acceptable for the setting.
- Students must respect program's grounds and refrain from damaging property.

CONSEQUENCES

1ST OFFENSE:

a warning is given and will be documented within ProCare

2ND OFFENSE:

time out from activities and will be documented within ProCare

3RD OFFENSE:

time out from activities, written documentation and/or parent contact. Will also be documented within ProCare.

Repeated offenses: After 3 offenses have been documented there will be a parent meeting requested and dismissal from program is possible.

If behavior is severe, regardless of the offense, parent will be contacted immediately.

Dismissal of a child from the program will occur at any time that a child's behavior is determined to be detrimental to his or her own well-being or to the well-being of others in the program.

Automatic dismissal will also occur when a child is habitually left after scheduled closing time (over two times in a one-month period) or by failure to promptly pay for the services.

All purchases need to be completed through our Parent Portal.




Drive-Thru
